

**Inuvialuit Former Residential School Students Information Form**

**INUVIK, NT (September 6, 2005)** - Nellie Cournoyea, Chair and Chief Executive Officer of Inuvialuit Regional Corporation (IRC), announces that IRC has mailed a letter and a form to all possible former residential school students on September 6, 2005. The information on the form will be used to:

1. determine the number of Inuvialuit who attended residential schools;
2. establish a list of all residential schools attended by Inuvialuit students;
3. provide the factual basis for IRC's lawsuit against the Government of Canada; and
4. assist with the negotiations of a settlement agreement with the Government of Canada.

**IRC asks that each Inuvialuit former residential school student complete and return the form to IRC by September 30, 2005.** The information is needed as soon as possible in order to ensure that the Government of Canada responds to IRC's position in a timely manner.

IRC's goal is to ensure that every Inuvialuit who attended residential school directly receives compensation from the Government of Canada.
