

OFFICIAL RULES

IRC CHRISTMAS CARD ART CONTEST

1. This contest is open to all students from kindergarten to grade 12 in the Inuvialuit Settlement Region and across Canada, except for employees of Inuvialuit Regional Corporation (IRC).
2. The subject (art) depicts “What does a traditional Inuvialuit Christmas mean to you?”
3. Each artwork entry must be accompanied by a signed entry form as supplied online or available from IRC and the Community Corporations.
4. The artwork entry must be hand drawn in either crayons, coloured pencils or pens, paint, water colours, etc.
5. Minimum recommended size of artwork is 4 inches x 6 inches. Maximum recommended size of artwork is 8 inches x 10 inches.
6. The original artwork entry, along with a signed entry form, must be mailed or dropped off at IRC or the Community Corporation offices. However, a photo of the artwork entry will be accepted by email or on IRC’s Facebook, Instagram and Twitter accounts – as long as the original entry is received by IRC or the Community Corporations by the end of the contest (November 3, 2017).
7. The contest starts on Tuesday, October 10, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. MST and ends on Friday, November 3, 2017 at 5:00 pm MST.
8. Prizes: THREE (3) winners will be selected. \$300 (VISA gift card) for first place, \$150 (VISA gift card) for second, and \$100 (VISA gift card) for third. The first-place winning artwork entry will be used as the design for the 2017 IRC corporate Christmas card.
9. Winner Selection and Notification: Winners will be selected by a group of IRC employees. Winners will be notified by phone or through their email or social media profile following the conclusion of the contest. If a winner cannot be contacted or is ineligible, the prize may be forfeited and an alternate winner selected. Winners must supply the original artwork of their winning entry before a prize is awarded.
10. The winning entrants must agree that their artwork will become the property of IRC; their names and reproductions of their winning entry will be published in the media; their original artwork will be featured on IRC’s Facebook page, website and social media sites.
